

**RULES AND REGULATIONS
PLUMBERS LOCAL UNION NO. 200
SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

A. INTRODUCTION

The Scholarship procedures are set forth in the Rules and Regulations of the Scholarship Fund, which are provided below.

Consistent with these Rules and Regulations, the Fund will issue scholarships to eligible applicants, as defined below, regardless of age, race, color, religion, national origin, sex, veteran status, affectional preference, disability, or marital status.

B. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Scholarship Fund shall award a scholarship with a stipend of \$ Amount To Be Determined

C. ELIGIBILITY RULES

1. To qualify, the applicant must be the natural or legally adopted son, daughter, or grandchild of a member in good standing of the Plumbers Local Union No. 200 so long as the member has been in good standing for at least five consecutive years at the time of application; or where the applicant is the natural or legally adopted son, daughter, or grandchild of a full time employee of the Union or its affiliated Funds (?).
2. Eligibility will not include circumstances where the member does not work at the trade, except as noted above (?).

3. Eligibility shall include where the member is deceased, but was a member in good standing for five years at the time of their death, and their spouse or life partner is receiving Plumber Local Union No. 200 Fringe Benefits.
4. Eligibility will not include circumstance where the member is on any type of withdrawal card.
5. Member must be in Good Standing, current with dues and no re-fee within 2 years.

D. APPLICATION RULES

1. To be considered eligible, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

Applications can be obtained from the Fund office, or downloaded from our website, completed are returned to the Fund by the advertised date. The application shall include the dependent's complete high school records including SAT scores, grades, and extracurricular activities. No application shall be acted upon by the Fund without the complete high school records certified by that school.

E. ADMINISTRATION OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

1. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the applicant to be credited to the students' account for payment of authorized covered expenses (college tuition, accommodations, room and board, and document matriculation and other usual and similar fees).
